# **Geographic Information Officer Report**

Officer Embley reviews membership responsibilities and considerations from the website and reminds all members to keep their pertinent information current from the website. New and updated GIS datasets are highlighted from the share-screen presentation that include: Delaware River <u>Islands of NJ</u> and PA; School <u>Point Locations</u> Public Private and Charter; update summary from the <u>Address page</u>; congressional district finder app.

**Geodetic Task Force Report** – Task Force Chairman Steve Eckhardt announces the latest datum the National Spatial Reference System 2022. This datum will replace those that are currently in use when it is released, likely 2025.

## **Elevation Task Force Report**

The final report from Task Force Chairman Mr Roger Barlow provides elevation task force updates from the meeting May 24, 2023. LiDar acquisition for northeast part of the State is ongoing. Quality Level 1 LiDar data for the following counties has been collected: Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Union, Middlesex, Monmouth. Buildings will be another feature that will be collected (anything in excess of 400sf), empowering Next Generation 9-1-1. Roger Barlow is resigning from his post that he has been in since 2007 and Roger's successor will be Eliza Gross and this is his last Geospatial Forum meeting while holding this official title. Three-dimensional hydrography program "3DHP" dataset should be published and available before October 1st (potentially). Many congratulations and much gratitude was offered by several members of the Community and on behalf of the New Jersey Geospatial Forum. Thank you, Roger, you will be missed here in New Jersey. Congratulations on your retirement!
