Presentation 1 – From Paper to Pixels: The Shift to Digital Utility Mapping

This presentation will cover how Colliers Engineering & Design (CED) used Esri and Eos technologies to assist in mapping out the City of Rahway, New Jersey's Sanitary and Stormwater Conveyance Systems. We will discuss the processes and workflow utilized to streamline field collection/verification of data; the technologies utilized for that collection; and how using real-time dashboards removed the necessity for time-consuming status meetings to update the City. By migrating this data from paper maps to GIS digital data, the City gained the ability to access the information through mobile and web-based applications and update their system in real-time.
